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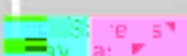

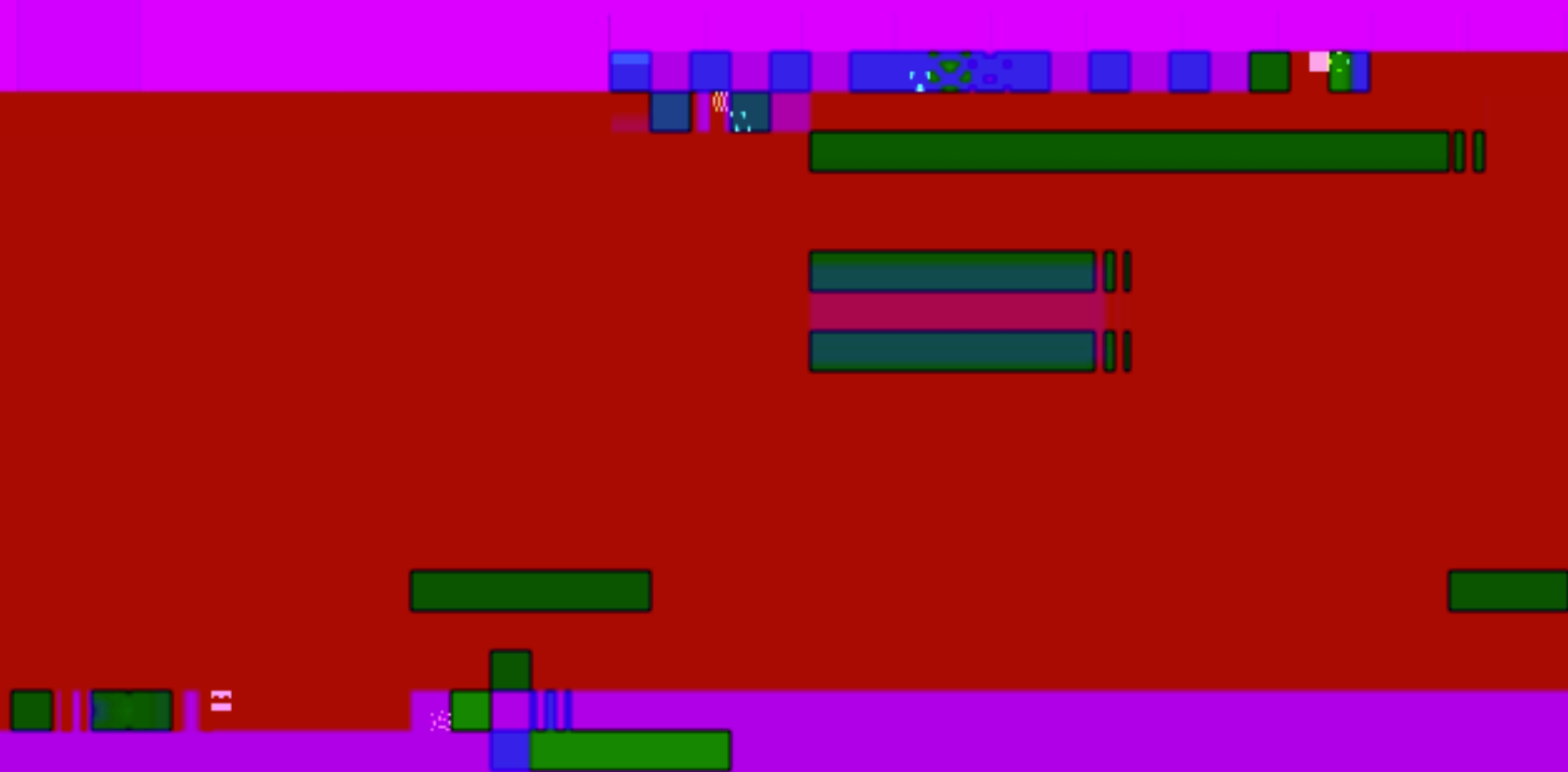

Answered: 77 Skipped: 2



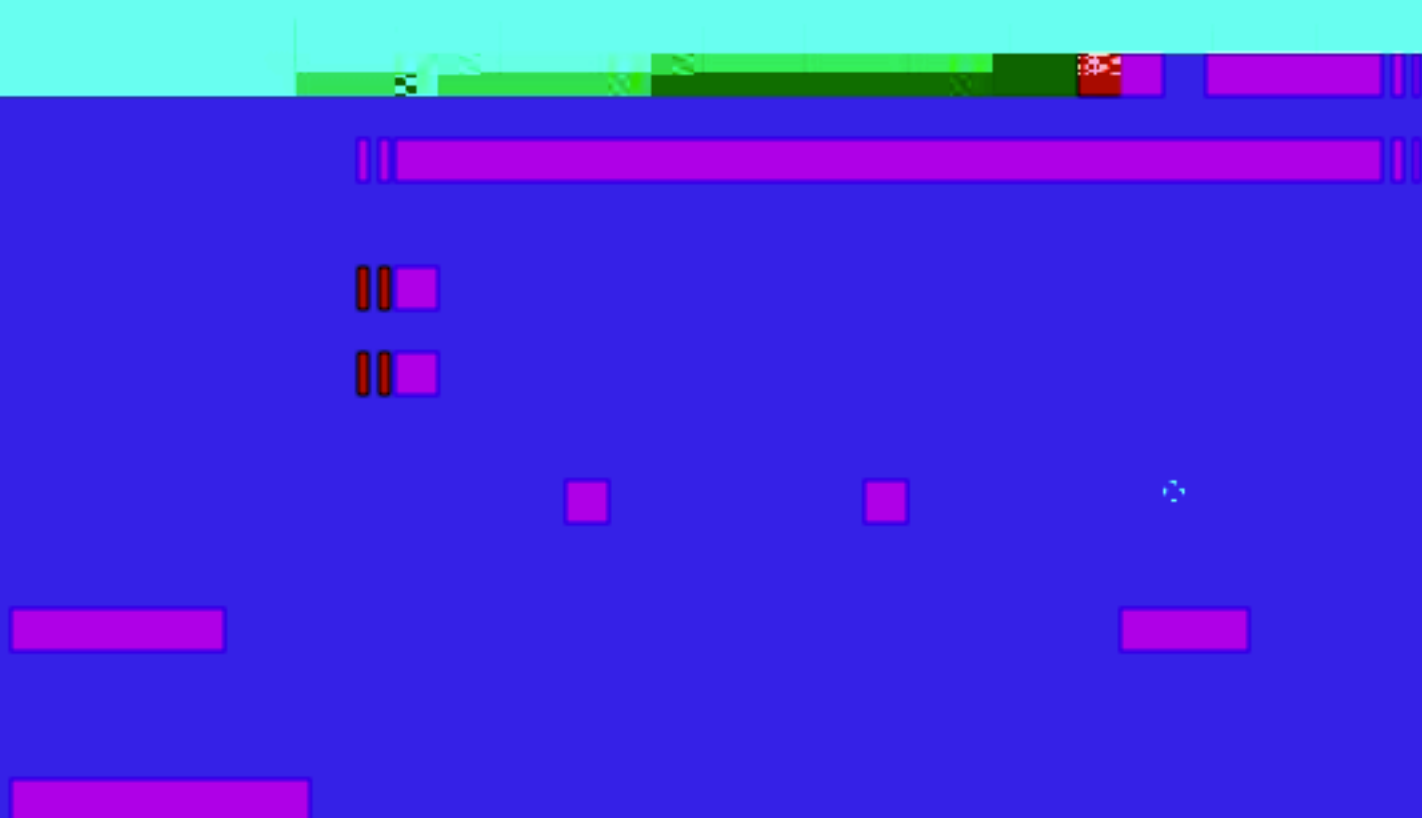
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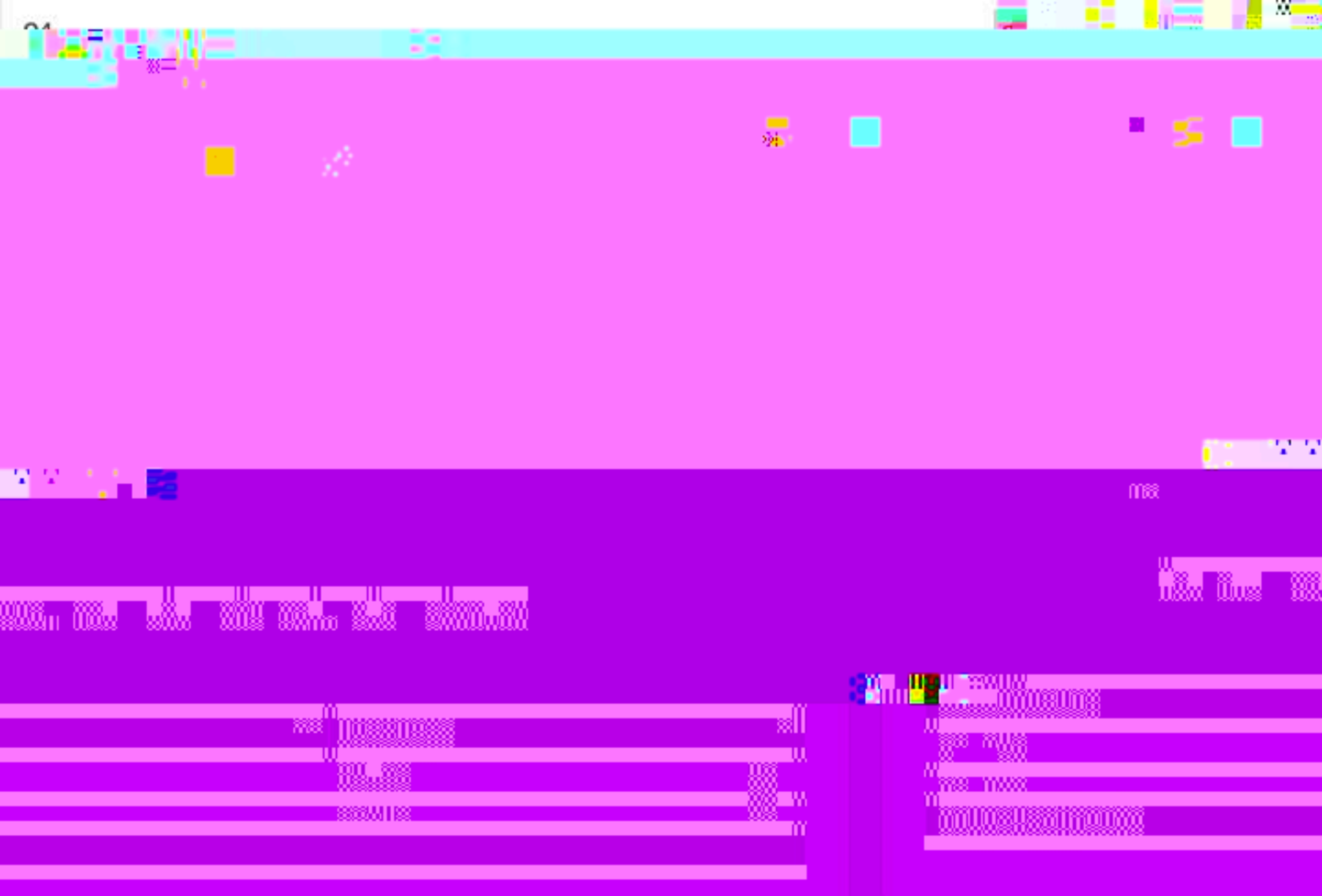
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Percentage

Answered: 79 Skipped: 0

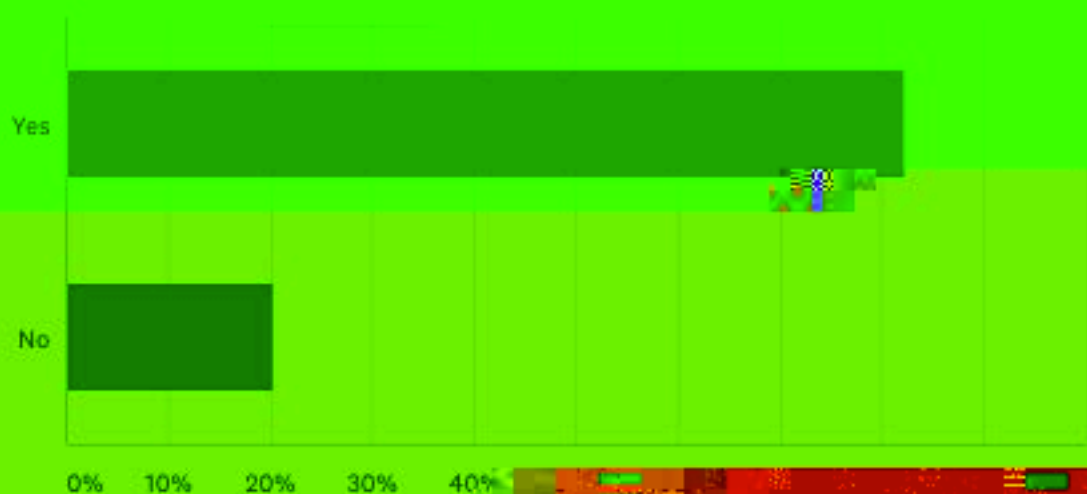






Would you be in support for mandatory Parent/Guardian participation that might include meetings with teachers and minimum volunteer hours in the school year?
