Subsequento completion of theStrengths and Needs Tooland disseminationof data to help inform regional discussion, an Interim Progress Report will be drafted by the BOCES District Superintendent, shared with their component school district governance teams, and then transmitted to NYSED on or before April 1, 2025After feedbackthe District Superintendent will submita Regionalization Plan on or before October 1, 2025These deadlines, as set forth in the regulation,also remain unchanged.

Finally, as a reminder, the Regionalization regulations are still out for public comment, and we encourage your continued engagement in the process.
